

5 DAY TRAINING PROGRAM ON T4D: DIGITAL DATA COLLECTION FOR MONITORING & EVALUATION EMPOWER YOURSELF TO EMPOWER OTHERS

FICCI Aditya Birla CSR Centre For Excellence organized a 5-day training program on digital data collection. The training was conducted from 16th August 2021 – 20th August 2021.

The online training program provided in-depth knowledge and training on building your own digital data collection systems to collect real-time and high-quality data. The training curriculum was designed for non-IT background professionals working in the social sector.

The below topics were covered-

- Transforming paper-based survey forms into digital copies (ODK/SurveyCTO).
- Designing and testing complex survey forms, learning randomization, and setting up automatic workflows for preloading data.
- Adding quality and data monitoring checks, integrating digital forms with external tools, and visualizing incoming data in real-time.
- Building your own dashboard to monitor all field activities and for tracking KPIs.
- Building your own computer-assisted telephonic interviews (CATI) and field tracking systems for collecting data offline/online through phone/web based medium.
- Learning best practices for collecting high-quality, secure data – both online and offline.

Representatives from Biocon Foundation, L&T Trust, Hyundai Motor India, Hindalco Industries, Lords Education & Health Society, ActionAid Association, PRADAN, Self-Reliant Initiatives through Joint Action (SRIJAN), Centre for Catalyzing change (C3), etc. attended the training program.
